



Flood Recovery Financial Assistance: Primary Producers

Recovery grants

Primary producers may be eligible for special disaster assistance recovery grants of up to \$75,000 to assist with clean-up and reinstatement activities.

Disaster Assistance Loans

Concessional interest rate loans of up to \$250,000 to assist primary producers whose assets have been significantly damaged as a direct result of the disaster, to recover and return to viable operations.

Disaster Assistance (Essential Working Capital) Loans

Concessional interest rate loans of up to \$100,000 to primary producers who have suffered a significant loss of income as a result of an eligible disaster by providing the essential working capital required to continue business operations.

Australian Government Disaster Recovery Allowance

The Disaster Recovery Allowance (DRA) provides income support payments to employees, primary producers and sole traders who can demonstrate they have experienced a loss of income as a direct result of the floods.

DRA provides fortnightly payments for up to 13 weeks up to the applicable rate of Newstart or Youth Allowance, depending on the person's circumstances.

Freight Subsidies for Primary Producers

Eligible primary producers can apply for a freight subsidy of up to \$5,000 per property to move essential materials such as fodder, building and fencing materials, machinery and animals for restocking.

Deferring your rent or instalment

All land rental invoices issued to eligible leaseholders with due dates ranging from 1 March 2019 to 30 November 2019, will receive an automatic extension to 1 December 2019. You do not need to apply.

Properties outside disaster-declared areas

Primary producers who have suffered significant damage as a result of a natural disaster event, but are not in a disaster-declared area, may apply for an Individual Disaster Stricken Property (IDSP) declaration. This declaration will give you access to assistance similar to Category B assistance of freight subsidies and concessional loans.
